

Jason Young is Director of the New Zealand Contemporary China Research Centre and Associate Professor of Political Science and International Relations at Victoria University of Wellington. He studied Chinese at Fu Jen University and Tunghai University in Taipei and Taichung and is a graduate of Otago University and Victoria University of Wellington.

Jason's research focuses on China's domestic politics and foreign policy and New Zealand-China relations. He is author of *China's Hukou System* (Palgrave 2013), the second edition of *Politics in Pacific Asia* (with Xiaoming Huang) and a number of journal articles and chapters in English and Chinese including articles in *Pacific Review* and *Political Science*. Jason is currently researching Chinese international relations writing on economic decoupling.
